Data Sharing

Why is information collected about you, how may the information be used and who will be collecting it?

<u>Care and Health Information Exchange (CHIE)</u> is an electronic summary record for people living in Hampshire, Portsmouth and Southampton. GP Surgeries, hospitals, social care and community care teams collect information about you and store it electronically on separate computer systems. The CHIE stores summary information from these organisations in one place so that, with your consent, professionals can view it to deliver better care to you. This record contains more information than the SCR, but is only available to organisations in Hampshire For more information visit www.hantshealthrecord.nhs.uk or phone 0300 123 1519

<u>Summary Care Record (SCR)</u> (in this area since Sept 2013) is a record that will contain important information about any medicines you are taking, allergies you suffer from and any bad reactions to medicines that you have had. This does not include diagnosis or procedures. Giving healthcare staff anywhere in the country access to this information can prevent mistakes being made when caring for you in an emergency or when your GP practice is closed.

<u>Care.Data</u> (started Spring 2014) is a modern information system that has been developed, which will make increased use of information from medical records with the intention of improving health services. Information such as your postcode and NHS number, but not your name, will be used.

Information will be held in a secure environment called the Health and Social Care Information Centre (HSCIC). The role of the HSCIC is to ensure that high quality data is used appropriately to improve patient care. The HSCIC has legal powers to collect and analyse data from all providers of NHS care. They are committed, and legally bound, to the very highest standards of privacy and confidentiality to ensure that your confidential information is protected at all times.

The information gathered by the programme can be used by NHS organisations to plan and design services better, using the best available evidence of which treatments and services have the greatest impact on improving patients' health. So ultimately, sharing your information will benefit YOU.

Sharing with other NHS Providers (via our computer system known as TPP SystmOne)

Sometimes it will be necessary for us to refer you to other NHS providers who use the same clinical system as us (TPP SystmOne).
